\$54,000	<a href="#">Monroe Congregational Church</a>	Jumbo triple-hung windows Low-E double-pane glass with internal spacers installed. Each opening contained over 45 square feet of glass.
\$146,000	<a href="#">Wesleyan University-Davison Health Center</a>	1848 gothic revival with 81 openings including elaborate “gingerbread” style trim work. Leaded glass windows were rebuilt and protected with glass cover panels on the exterior.
\$80,000	<a href="#">Wesleyan University- Center for the Americas</a>	Built in 1838. Over 50 openings including triple-hung sash. Utilized tempered double-pane glass to simulate original ‘wavy’ glass
\$101,000	<a href="#">106 Prospect Street East Side, Providence, RI</a>	1912 mansion in historic district (required commission approval). 71 openings including custom French casements on 3 <sup>rd</sup> floor.
\$77,500	<a href="#">Wesleyan University-South College</a>	President’s building. All windows including jumbo French casement with transom (60 square feet of glass)
\$250,000	<a href="#">Newtown Town Hall</a>	Restoration of historic building
\$155,000	<a href="#">Yale University (Stoeckel Hall)</a>	LEEDS certified (gold) Elaborate Venetian-style sashes
\$38,000	<a href="#">Katharine Hepburn Cultural Arts Center</a>	Old Saybrook, CT
\$32,000	115 Asylum Street, Hartford	Original Stackpole, Moore & Tryon building
\$37,000	<a href="#">Old Lyme Memorial Town Hall</a>	Original large 15/15 & 12/12 restored in original building. Blended in with new construction addition new Marvin windows utilized.
\$35,000	<a href="#">East 70th NYC brownstone</a>	Oldest surviving house in the upper east side historic district. Required landmarks approval
\$28,000	Newtown Meeting Hall	Circa 1792 building
\$58,000	Rockville Hospital	Maxwell House
\$103,000	Plumb Memorial Library	Richardson Romanesque style with bent glass windows
